@ 13 and over - Prelims in the AM (open events) with a de-qualifying time of PNS 14 and under Championship for 13-14 year old/Washington State champs for 15 and over;. The 13 and over swimmers do not have qualifying time – only de-qualifying times.

Overall Pentathlon placement is determined by total time for all five (5) events. An event DQ disqualifies swimmer from overall Pentathlon awards. A swimmer must compete in all five events to be considered for awards. In the 11-12 age groups, a swimmer who has a PNS Championship time in the pentathlon events will be ineligible for Pentathlon awards.
