LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS

Olympic Swim Center
7070 Stampede Blvd
Silverdale, Washington

Directions from I-5: Take Hwy 16 (Bremerton exit) to Hwy 3. Go north to Newberry Hill exit. Turn right off ext. Turn right at light onto Buklin Hill Road (several miles). Turn right onto Nels Nelson Road. Past the fairgrounds, Nels Nelson becomes Stampede. Turn right at entrance to high school. Pool is on the right, below stadium.

From Seattle ferry: Exit the ferry into the tunnel and merge onto Burwell. Turn right onto Warren Ave. Across the bridge, Warren becomes Wheaton Way. Go about three miles, then turn left onto Fairgrounds Road. Turn left onto Stampede. Turn right at entrance to high school. Pool is on the right, below stadium.

FACILITY

- 25 yard, 6-lane competitive pool
- Starting end 12.0 feet deep; turning end 4.0 feet deep
- The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).
- Warm-up pool adjacent to turn end of pool
- 200 spectator seats
- Colorado timing system
- Scoreboard: six-lane readout
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing in or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

ELIGIBILITY:

- All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming and Pacific Northwest Swimming through an above-listed team.
- Age groups are based on the age of the swimmer as of the first day of the meet. Ages and age groups for competition will be 8&under, 9-10, 11-12, and 13&O. See Order of Events and Entry Information.
- **Qualifying and de-qualifying times:** There are no qualifying times, but there are de-qualifying times for all 11&O swimmers. See Special Information and Rules for each session.



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ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Swimmers must meet the specific entry requirements for each individual event they enter.
- On-deck USA Swimming registration will not be permitted. On-deck transfer to one of the listed teams will not be permitted.
- Deck entries for individual events will be allowed only in unassigned lanes during preliminary and pentathlon sessions and only at the discretion of the Meet Referee. No deck entries during the finals sessions. Deck entry individual swims are not eligible for any awards, team points, or advancement from prelims to finals. Deck entry fees must be paid prior to the swim.
- Deck entered swimmers who are not already in the meet are required to show proof of USA Swimming athlete registration through PNS and complete a PNS Deck Entry Registration at the Clerk of Course in order to enter.
- All USA Swimming registration numbers will be verified with the PNS registration database.

ENTRY FEES:

- Surcharge: \$5.00
- Deck entry surcharge: \$10.00 (swimmer not previously in meet)
- Individual events: \$4.00
- No refunds or credits will be given for events entered but not swum.
- All fees must accompany entries.

MEET RULES:

- Current PNS and USA Swimming rules govern throughout the meet, including warm-ups.

SPECIAL INFORMATION AND RULES FOR 10&U PENTATHLON SESSIONS:

- Each 10&U Pentathlon swimmer may enter up to a maximum of five (5) individual events. Entries exceeding this limit will be scratched without notification, and entry fees for entry count limitation scratches will not be refunded.
- All 9-10 events will be seeded and swum together by gender, but scored separately by age group and gender (9 and 10).

Qualifying times: There are no qualifying or de-qualifying times for 10&U swimmers.

Awards and Scoring:

- **Pentathlon Awards** for each age group and gender: 8&U, 9, and 10. The winners of the Pentathlon awards will be the swimmers with the least amount of accumulated time for the five events. A swimmer who is disqualified in one or more individual events is not eligible for Pentathlon Awards. To be eligible for Pentathlon awards, a swimmer must be pre-entered in and compete in all five events for his/her age group/gender. Trophy for overall winner in each age group and gender with certificates for 2nd-8th places.
- **Ribbons:** 1st thru 8th for individual events in each awards age group.
- No team points.

Special Pentathlon Session Rules:

- All Pentathlon events will be timed finals.
- Any swimmer who deck-enters one or more events is not eligible for pentathlon awards.

SPECIAL INFORMATION AND RULES FOR 11&OPRELIMS/FINALS SESSIONS:

- Each eligible swimmer may enter up to a maximum of three (3) individual events per day. Entries exceeding this limit will be scratched without notification, and entry fees for entry count limitation scratches will not be refunded.
- Events will be swum and scored by event number.

De-qualifying times: The de-qualifying period for all age groups starts September 1, 2011.

- Swimmers age 11-14 have no qualifying times but may not enter any event in which they have achieved a 14&U PNS Champs time (any course).
- Swimmers age 15&O have no qualifying times but may not enter any event in which they have achieved a Washington State Short Course Champs time (any course).

Awards and Scoring:

- Individual events: Medals 1st-6th places; ribbons 7th-12th places.
- Scoring: 16-13-12-11-10-9-7-5-4-3-2-1

Scratch information and Session Rules:

- **Prelims:** No check-in required. No penalty for failure to show.
- **Finals:** These are preliminary/finals sessions, with two 11-12 heats and two 13&O heats of each event in finals. Swimmers whose names are announced as qualifying for the finals or consolation heat of any prelims/finals event who fail to show will be barred from competing in the next individual event in which they are entered unless properly scratched. Once event results are announced, finalists and consolation finalists have 30 minutes to declare their intention to scratch. Swimmers declaring an intention to scratch will have until 30 minutes after the completion of their last preliminary event of the session to finalize their intention to scratch. There is no penalty for scratches during this time.
- Athletes who are seeded into an event as a result of other athletes scratching will not themselves be penalized for a failure to properly scratch. Reseeding to include scratches made after the scratch deadline may occur at the discretion of the Meet Referee.
- Any swimmer who deck enters an event may not advance to finals or otherwise score.

WARM-UP PROCEDURES FOR ALL SESSIONS:

- Circle swim counter-clockwise only.
- Last half hour of each warm-up period:
 - Lanes 1 & 6—pace lanes, no diving
 - Lanes 2 & 5—sprint lanes, dive starts, return in lanes 3 & 4
 - Lanes 3 & 4—general warm-up, no diving



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- Additional sprint lanes may be made available upon request to the Meet Referee.
- Pool closed promptly five (5) minutes prior to the start of competition.
- Warm-up may be modified at the discretion of the Meet Referee to accommodate the number of swimmers entered.

SAFETY:

- No diving from the blocks or sides of pool except for designated sprint lanes during designated times in main pool.
- Jumping into the pool is not allowed.
- Backstroke swimmers enter the water feet first in rotation; no diving over persons in the water.
- Deck Marshals will be assigned to supervise the warm-up. Deck Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer, coach, or club who does not follow the safety rules during warm-ups or the meet.
- Coaches are responsible for their team's swimmers throughout the meet, including warm-ups and warm-downs.
- All participating swimmers must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach and may not enter the water at any time unless under the supervision of said coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist a swimmer in making supervision arrangements, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make arrangements prior to the start of warm-ups and to so notify the Meet Referee.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

OTHER NOTES:

- In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that PNS and USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
- Only authorized volunteers and working personnel can be on deck. All others must remain in the designated spectator area and are not allowed in the designated racing venue unless timing for an event or volunteering with the management of the meet.
- In order to be on deck and serve in their official capacity, all coaches, officials and any other person required by sanction to be members of USA Swimming shall visibly display their membership credentials at all times.
- All persons acting in any coaching capacity must be coach members of USA Swimming.
- Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products of any kind, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue.
- Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate disqualification from the meet and the loss of any points accumulated toward team standings by the individual.
- Team Areas: Please keep your area clean, and pick up all trash before leaving each session.

ENTRY SUBMITTAL INFORMATION:

Entries will be only be accepted upon receipt of all of the following prior to the entry deadline, November 21, 2012:

1. **Entry File** from Team Manager or equivalent.
2. **Meet Entry Reports** for individual (sorted by swimmer) and relay (sorted by event) events from Team Manager or equivalent.
3. **Meet Entry Fee Report** from Team Manager or equivalent.
4. **Master Entry Summary Form**—Completed and hand-signed hardcopy only (original or faxed); typed signatures will not be accepted
5. **Meet Entry Fees**—one check payable to the Olympic Aquatic Club.

Submittal Formats:

- **Electronic files:** email items #1, #2, and #3.
- **Hardcopies:** mail or hand-deliver items #4 and #5. If sending via express mail, waive signature requirement.
- To ensure correct entries, teams that do not have Team Manager or equivalent software can use Hy-Tek Lite to complete and submit entries for this meet. It is available at <http://www.hy-tek.com/downloads/html> at no charge.

Submittal Notes:

- Late, incomplete, or paper entries will not be processed.
- Recheck all entries as no additional entries or corrections will be accepted after the deadline (except deck entries).
- All entry times must be SCY (short course yards).
- Your cooperation is appreciated in facilitating the entry process by making your entries complete, orderly, and legible.

@ 11 and over - Prelims in the AM (open events) with a de-qualifying time of PNS 14 and under Championship for 11-14 year old/Washington State champs for 15 and over; The 11 and over swimmers do not have qualifying time – only de-qualifying times.

Overall Pentathlon placement is determined by total time for all five (5) events. An event DQ disqualifies swimmer from overall Pentathlon awards. A swimmer must compete in all five events to be considered for awards.

PNS shall require the club or responsible party to pay an amount equal to the current full-year USA Swimming athlete registration fee, including the PNS surcharge, plus a \$15.00 fine for each athlete who is registered from the pre-meet exception report. The fines are due prior to the entry deadline of the next meet entered by the team being fined or within 15 business days after the receipt of the fine statement, whichever occurs first.
