FAMILY TRAVEL

As it was for 2021, Age Group Zones will **AGAIN be a family travel meet in 2022**. Selected athletes & families will be responsible for their own travel, lodging and meal arrangements (with the exception of the two team dinners). Prior to departure, a general schedule will be provided for the duration of the meet and a daily schedule will be provided during the meet with prelims/finals specifics and any other scheduled team activities. Athletes are expected to fully adhere to the team schedule and to arrive/depart on time for meet warmups and any other team activities. Athletes who fail to follow the team schedule during the trip will be scratched from the meet and sent home.

PNS ZONE TEAM

While we are not traveling as a team, the coaches and staff consider the meet a TEAM championship. This is an opportunity for us to come together as a TEAM with our talented PNS age groupers and represent the LSC against the top swimmers in the Western Zone. This is our chance as a TEAM to showcase our fast age groupers at the championship and we appreciate a high level of cooperation from all participating athletes, coaches and traveling parents/guardians.

ELIGIBILITY

Western Zone Age Group Championships is a selection meet for PNS. Eligible swimmers must have achieved a 2022 Western Zone Time Standard within the qualifying time period at a sanctioned USA Swimming competition as verified by SWIMS database.

TEAM ROSTER – SELECTION PROCESS

LSC's are allowed to take up to 80 swimmers who have achieved a qualifying time for the Western Zone Age Group Championships. The TEAM goal for our LSC is to take the most competitive team to the meet to allow our athletes the opportunity to compete against the best in the West. All qualifying times will be considered - SCY, SCM, LCM - during the selection process. The Zone Team coaches and team manager will meet to jointly select the team based on the following factors:

All qualified swimmers that apply will be selected for age groups that have twelve (12) or less applicants.

For age groups with more than 12 swimmers who apply, the following factors will be taken into consideration when picking the swimmers for the Zone team:

- Zone event rankings
- 2. Relay scoring potential
- 3. Number of events qualified



- 4. Championship meet experience
- 5. IMX & Power Point scores
- 6. Meet availability

Additional swimmers may also be selected as determined to be needed by the Zone Team Coaches for underserved age groups, events and relays and as provided per meet rules and within the 80 athlete limit. Two (2) 12&under disability athletes and two (2) 13-14 disability athletes may also be selected to the Zone Team. Two (2) alternates will be selected, when available, for each gender and age group to fill duties on the team should a selected team member have to bow out of the meet.

Athletes who anticipate qualifying after the deadline and/or who are very close to the qualifying standards are encouraged to apply for consideration by the application deadline.

MEET ENTRIES

Zone Team Coaches will make the final decision on all entries based on what is best for the TEAM. Zone Team Coaches will strive to provide each athlete with at least one (1) swim each day participating.

Athletes are limited to six (6) individual events for the entire meet and no more than three (3) *individual* events per day. Entries may be further limited based on the overall LSC entry limitations of the championship, including both total entries and bonus events.

PNS may enter two (2) relays per event. <u>All relays will compete as following: "A" Relays will swim at</u> Finals slowest to fastest and "B" relays will swim at the conclusion of Prelims fastest to slowest.

In representing Pacific Northwest Swimming, athletes commit to properly prepare for the meet and each race. Athletes must attend all prelim sessions that they have entered and are expected to swim all finals sessions that they make it back to. Athletes that fail to properly scratch from prelim events will be not allowed to compete in other events that day. Athletes that fail to properly scratch from a finals race will be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet.

OPENING CEREMONIES & SOCIAL EVENTS

Due to COVID protocols, the social event schedule is as follows:

- Opening Ceremonies will NOT take place on Tuesday night. A special recognition of all athletes attending the meet will take place at the beginning of the Preliminary Session on Wednesday morning.
- Saturday Finals "exchange" of team gear RETURNS!
- Saturday Night Athlete Dinner & Social will be held this year. Information will be available on the event website.

SPECTATOR ADMISSIONS & SEATING:

Final details on spectator numbers will be distributed to each LSC no later than July 15, 2022. Additionally, final details on ticket sales will be distributed to each LSC no later than July 15, 2022. Spectator seating will be located in a designated section and this is a CLOSED-DECK meet; only credentialed athletes, coaches, officials and volunteers are allowed on the pool deck. There will be no admission of spectators to the competition deck. Details on Live Streaming, if possible, will be shared as soon as it is available.

PARENT HELP

<u>We will need parent help throughout the meet</u>. Per Western Zone policy, each LSC is required to have at least one adult chaperone in the assigned Team Areas supervising their LSC athletes whenever their athletes are in the Team Area.

PNS is also required to supply timers for each session of prelims and finals. The Zone Team Manager will create a job signup prior to the meet to fill in our parent assignments. Parents who serve as officials are



encouraged to work sessions throughout the meet. <u>Parents who volunteer must have completed a USA Swimming background check and the Athlete Protection Course.</u>

TEAM DINNERS

On Tuesday August, 2nd and Friday August 5th, we will have a TEAM dinner for our athletes and coaches ONLY to create a TEAM atmosphere for the swimmers and coaches with family travel for the meet this year. Cost for the athletes' dinner is included in the participation fee cost. Parents are encouraged to use this time to have dinner with other parents or explore the area. Location and time for dinners TBD and will be communicated to the Zone team member selected. Approximate time for the team dinners will be an hour and a half.

TRAVEL

Athletes are encouraged to be there for the whole meet to participate in the TEAM dinners and Saturday Zone social.

Recommended travel dates:

Depart for Elk Grove (Sacramento) – Tuesday, August 2, arrival early to make 5:00pm practice at the competition pool and team dinner after Return to Seattle – Sunday, August 7

LODGING

Families may stay wherever they choose, but are encouraged to stay as close to the pool as possible.

PARTICIPATION FEE

<u>Total cost for participation is \$150.</u> The participation fee covers the cost of entries, surcharges, team apparel and two team dinners: Tuesday August 2nd and Friday August 5th. Athletes will be responsible for all other trip expenses.

The participation fee is due with submission of the athlete application and will NOT be refunded unless an athlete is not selected to the team. If for some reason a selected athlete is not able to make the trip after the team has been announced, there will NOT be any refunds as the full cost has been committed by PNS to support each athlete. Athletes who do not swim in the meet will NOT receive any of the team items given to the participating swimmers.

CODE OF CONDUCT

All team members, team staff, and parents of minors are apprised in writing of this Code of Conduct and the attached USA Swimming Code of Conduct. A signature on this document constitutes unconditional agreement to comply with the stipulations of both documents.

- a. Team members will display proper respect and sportsmanship toward coaches, officials, administrators, teammates, volunteers and fellow competitors while on the trip.
- b. The possession or use of alcohol, tobacco products, controlled substances, is prohibited throughout the designated duration of the trip. The Team Manager needs to be informed in writing as part of the athlete's application of all prescription medication, dietary supplements, or other drugs being brought on the trip by individual athletes.
- c. No "deck changes" are permitted. Athletes are expected to use available change facilities.
- d. Team members and staff will refrain from any illegal or inappropriate behavior that would detract from a positive image of the team or be detrimental to its performance objectives.
- e. Swimmers are to refrain from inappropriate physical contact at team activities and events.
- f. Swimmers are to refrain from use of inappropriate language.
- g. Athletes and team staff must abide by the SafeSport Code for the U.S. Olympic and Paralympic Movement.
- h. LSC team members are reminded that when competing in meets, traveling on trips, and attending other meet related functions, they are representing both themselves and the Pacific Northwest Swimming. Athlete behavior must positively reflect the high standards of Pacific Northwest Swimming.
- i. Additional guidelines may be established as needed to assure the safety and well-being of the team members and will be adhered to during the trip.

I understand that failure to comply with the Pacific Northwest Swimming Code of Conduct, as set forth in this document or additions necessary for the safety and well-being of the team members may result in disciplinary action, which may include but is not limited to the following:

- 1. Disqualification from one or more swimming activities.
- 2. Dismissal from team and return home at my own/parent's expense.
- 3. The infraction(s) will be reported to the PNS Board who may take additional disciplinary action including but not limited to disqualification from future PNS sponsored activities.
