    - Coaches meeting tomorrow (11 January 2022]. Alice has talked to the Lobbyist who stated that at this time we're expecting Governor Inslee to have pools/teams use self-governance (v. State mandated) adherence to COVID guidelines.

- Safe Sport Report Carl Baber
  - USA Swimming is no longer requiring Meet Marshalls to be non-athlete members (directive was to go
    into effect 1 January), although this may change in the future.
- Finance Report Dave Baer see attached.
  - PNS in good financial shape
  - \$250K was taken out of Reserves in 2021, but thanks to a favorable stock market, net Reserves increased in the year.
  - Meet Tap is (understandably) lagging past year averages (fewer meets due to COVID)
  - Fiscal Year to Date Income is ~\$125K
  - "Special Programs" refers to PNS Board approved donations to SplashForward and Whidbey Island pool initiatives
- Diversity Report Emily Murray no report.
  - Alice noted that Tatiana provided a report from her attendance at a Women in Leadership workshop; she learned a lot and highly recommends sending others if presented in the future
- Disability Report Kiko VanZandt no report.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- April Zone Workshop
  - Formerly the Zone Workshop, will be 21-24 April 2022 in Denver and will utilize virtual committee meetings
  - September HOD (at USA Swimming level) will be primarily virtual
  - o PNS needs to select how many to send to Denver; so far we have Alice, David O., John S., and Chad
- 2022 (Q1 and Q2) Meet Calendar see "Swim Meet Information and Bid Deadlines" from the 6 January What's PNeu -- https://www.teamunify.com/pnws2/UserFiles/File/BODHODMinutes/pns-meet-information-january--july-revised-010622 095119.pdf
  - Western Senior Sectionals moved from KCAC to Phoenix in March
  - Washington State Age Group Champs (in lieu of Age Group Sectionals) 18-20 March, a meet for 11–18year-olds; time standards have been established, Swimmers who qualify for Senior Sectionals may not participate in this meet
  - Spring Fling 26-27 March for those who have not qualified for Senior Sectionals or Washington State Age Group Champs; time standards have been established
  - Hosts are needed! Encourage all teams to submit bids for these and other meets; Alignments for spring meets should be out in late February
  - KCAC is actively working to hire more lifeguards
- Team Selection Process Task Team
  - Board needs to pull information (regarding the selection processes) to share at HOD; David O. has been tasked to do this. HOD does not need to approve, but rather Board wants to ensure HOD members are aware of the processes used

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Nominating Committee
  - January starts the process to formulate selection of candidates to replace outgoing Board members
  - Nominating Committee is generally comprised of Governance Committee members.
  - Need help in identifying candidates as some of the Board positions are term-limited.
- Parliamentarian Support
  - Some LSC's are creating or utilizing a Parliamentarian position to ensure proper use of Robert's Rules of Order for Board meetings, etc.; some use professional consultants (~\$100-500/hour).
  - o No specific action for PNS Board at this time, but do we want to plan/prepare for it in the future?

### Treasurers Report

As our total assets exceed \$200K, we are required to have a financial review performed and provided to USA Swimming. Both actions are planned to be complete before the HOD meeting in May and will be available for BOD review as we prepare for the HOD.

### Finance Report

Ending December, PNS is in good financial shape. While meet tap income is reduced, USA Registration income is almost fully recovered. Despite significant withdrawals from the reserve accounts (\$243K), the stock performance of our portfolio has been excellent and we had a net increase in reserves.








Early Registrations almost to pre-Covid income








Meet Tap Income significantly down as compared to Pre-COVID








Total Income improved

### Safe Sport Report

#### Safe Sport PNS Board Meeting Monday Jan 10th

- Delay for Meet Marshals for being "certified" as non-USA members.
- · Does not change the individuals that must be certified.
  - · "Specifically in reference to requiring non-athlete membership of meet marshals, USA Swimming received a significant amount of member feedback. As a result of that feedback, USA Swimming requested a specific review from the Center regarding the role of a meet marshal and whether it meets the threshold of a volunteer who interacts directly and frequently with athletes or has authority over athletes as a regular part of their duties. We recently received confirmation from the Center that the role of a meet marshal does not rise to the level of contact with or authority over athletes significant enough to require non-athlete membership of these volunteers. The Board of Directors acted quickly to approve amending Corporate Bylaw 2.6.6 to remove the requirement for meet marshals to register as non-athlete members of USA Swimming. Concurrently, the Operational Risk Committee has worked to standardize the role of a meet marshal and developed Meet Marshal Standards. The Committee has also developed a standard meet marshal training program, which will be released in 2022

Please note, this change is only in reference to meet marshals, and all other communicated categories will still be required to become non-athlete members of USA Swimming no later than January 1, 2022. These individuals include:

- Adult employees of USA Swimming, Local Swimming Committees (LSCs) and member clubs;
- Adults serving on the board of directors of USA Swimming, LSCs and member clubs;
- Individuals in a position of oversight over the operations of a member club;
- Adults with an ownership interest in a member club;
- Referees, starters, administrative officials, chief judges, as well as stroke and turn judges; and
- Other volunteers who interact directly and frequently with or have authority over athletes (as defined in the SafeSport Code for the Olympic and Paralympic Movement) as a regular part of their duties.
- I do see this potentially taking place for meet marshals for next season(I hope). The Operational Committee is working on a training program that is well delayed and has not been approved by the USA board & Safe Sport. The level of the program is supposed to use with testing for Meet Marshals.
- I would like to attend the April Zone Workshop meeting to continue Safe Sport Work. Old Business
