2025-26 Pacific Northwest Swimming Meet Bid process

In this packet, you will find:

- 1) Directions & things to consider when filling out your bids for next years schedule.
- 2) Meet Bid Form. Please fill out one of these for each meet you would like to host.
- 3) Part B: please fill these out for each special meet. PNS Technical planning & Program Operations is responsible for the design of those meets. (Blue on calendar)
- 4) Meet Calendar: Some notes:
 - a. PNS designed meets are listed in Blue. Technical planning designs the order of events, time standards, etc.
 - b. On PNS designed weekends, no other meets may run unless it states that the weekend is also a special weekend.
 - c. Weekends where WKCAC is available is notes. Except in the cases of champs meets where the goal is to move around the hosts if possible to give more teams championship hosting experience, previous hosts are given priority.
 - d. WKCAC is unsure of some weekend availability in June due to special Olympics. If you are interested in hosting a meet in June at WKCAC, please submit a bid and once the weekends are decided, we will sort it out.

Once all bids are received and reviewed for accuracy, the scheduling committee will meet to award all PNS designated meets and any potential conflicts with facilities (two teams trying to host a meet at the same facility).

The scheduling chair along with the scheduling committee will work to resolve any remaining conflicts.

For PNS designated meets that require multiple hosts, if enough hosts are not received by the date on the calendar, the weekends will be converted to special meet weekends and hosts can create their own meets.

<u>Please Read before filling out the bid form:</u>

Thank you so much for your willingness to host a meet to support the growth of our sport and give our athletes opportunities to continue to improve.

While the primary goal of hosting a meet should not be the financial benefit, we also recognize that teams use these meets for fundraising. To that degree, we want to make sure that teams understand the volunteerism necessary to run a successful meet.

As a host, you are responsible for providing the following volunteers:

- 1) Finding a Meet Referee and working on arranging the supporting officials. While you should have officials to meet the 15:1 PNS goal for 2025/26, teams attending your meet should also be helping to supply officials. See below for PNS recommendations for officials during a session.
- 2) Providing Clerk of Course, staging helpers (if necessary), head timers, an announcer, & Meet Marshalls.
- 3) Providing hospitality for officials and coaches as necessary.
- 4) Non-KCAC meets: Providing timers for all timed final and final sessions in a 6 lane pool. (When using more than 6 lanes, teams can be assigned lanes but the host should still provide some of the timers). At WKCAC,. During prelim sessions or timed final sessions, the host should provide timers equal to their percentage of athletes in the meet. For finals, the host team should provide timers for all 8 lanes.

Should your meet be prelims/finals, it is customary for the visiting teams to help support timing needs during prelims and the host team providing timers for finals.

Should the above volunteer expectations be a challenge for your team, we HIGHLY encourage you to reach out to neignoring clubs and work together to co-host the meet. Co-hosting is a great opportunity for teams to work together. If you are unsure of possible arranges, for co-hosting a meet, please reach out to Program Operations or the Scheduling chair for possible Solutions and ways teams can work together.

Pacific Northwest Swimming Officials Recommendations.

In order to keep the professionalism at our meets and to not burn out our officials, PNS is STRONGLY encouraging <u>ALL TEAMS</u>, regardless of whether or not they host meets, **to have an Officials ratio of 15:1**. (for every 15 athletes on a team, 1 certified official).

During the course of a meet, PNS Recommends the following minimum recommendation for the number of Officials working during a session :

2 deck refs, 2 starters, 6 stroke & turn, 1 AO & 1 meet Ref.
